

How We Do It

Dear Friends,

I want to express my sincere gratitude to all of you who make up the CTP family. You empower us to make a difference in helping people with disabilities achieve greater independence in their lives. Thank you.

Last year our impact report focused on answering the question of how we define success. Success within our program is defined by each person who comes to us for help and is unique to their individual goals and needs.

Over the years (decades!), I've been asked to state the success of our program with metrics. While the desire to quantify results is understandable, no one thinks of their own story as a number. We see that success comes in many forms and it is not always about achieving the initial goal.

The deeper question concerning success is then, how is it that we help people find success? CTP has 5 key principles that guide our work. These principles establish a practical framework for making progress and overcoming barriers.

- Respect uniqueness
- Believe in human capacity
- Establish trust
- Build confidence
- Set expectations

By embracing all of these principles, CTP can nurture professional skills through honest feedback that students can hear and internalize. Our focus on expectations and accountability helps CTP students transform into employment candidates or realistically assess what they need to work on in their lives to take the next step.

Computer Essentials

A great introductory class for those with beginner-level computer skills or those who have extremely out-of-date computer experience.

Computer Skills Bootcamp

Focuses on the efficient use of computers for workplace tasks and is an opportunity to practice professional accountability. Students will gain a better understanding of their unique strengths and weaknesses, refine their career goals, and clarify what they will need to do to achieve those goals.

Computer Technician Training

Ideal for those interested in computers and technology. Develop a personal problem-solving methodology, and build professional skills and confidence in being able to do the job. Come geek out with us!

PRO Customer Service and Administrative Training

Ideal for those who are seeking entry-level employment in an office or customer service role. Strengthen computer usage skills, hone professionalism and find your place in the employment world.

Work Experience

Participants join the CTP team as paid IT/Admin Associates. Associates gain real work experience to practice their skills, boost their confidence, and establish a work reference.

Supported Job Search

Our highly-effective structured system for job searching with 1:1 support. We're with you till you find your job.

Career Development Support

Retention support lasts a minimum of 90 days, and long-term support as part of the CTP family.

In 2023, CTP launched a work experience program for graduates to gain professional experience, build confidence, and hone their skills in a real work environment.




Michael's Success Story

The supportive environment and encouraging atmosphere fostered at Delta Dental have left an indelible mark on Michael's personal and professional growth.

During the start of his internship, Michael struggled with remote connectivity issues, however, Michael did not have to face them alone. Delta Dental, CTP, and the DOR collaborated to help



find a solution to Michael's connectivity issues. The collective dedication to Michael's success became evident as the collaborative worked to quickly address and overcome the hurdles he encountered.

Through his internship, Michael continued to thrive in the supportive, remote environment created by Delta Dental.

After completing his internship in the Spring of 2024, Michael has decided to pursue a BA degree.

Jim had always found his calling in the kitchen. With a passion for culinary arts, he had crafted delectable dishes and delighted diners for years. But life took an unexpected turn when an injury sidelined his career as a chef.


Despite the setback, he refused to let adversity define him. Referred to the Department of Rehabilitation (DOR) by his doctor, he was then directed to CTP for PRO Customer Service and Administrative Training. Jim approached his training with unwavering determination and a positive attitude. He acknowledged that transitioning to remote work would be a challenge, but he refused to be deterred. Day by day, he honed his skills, eager to carve out a new path for himself.



After finishing his training, Jim joined CTP's Supported Job Search Program to look for work. Aware of the daunting task ahead, Jim braced himself for the challenges of job hunting. He knew it wouldn't be easy. Knowing the job market would be fiercely competitive, Jim set himself a bold target: to accumulate 50 rejections within his first month of searching.

To Jim's surprise after just a few short weeks of job hunting he landed a remote customer service job—a role he had been hoping for, proving that even in the face of daunting challenges, success is achievable.


